

Appendix 3: Data protection regulations

§ 1 Scope of application

The following data protection provisions apply to the use of Internet access by the member. The legal basis for data protection can be found in the EU General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter GDPR) and the Bundesdatenschutzgesetz (BDSG).

§ 2 Definitions

A) Personal data

"Personal data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.

B) Processing

"Processing" means any operation or set of operations which is performed upon personal data, whether or not by automatic means.

§ 3 Types of personal data and purpose of data processing

FTC processes the following personal data in case of internet use:

- First and last name, date of birth and contact details of the members,
- Access data (username, password)
- Date and time of access,
- Internet pages accessed,
- IP address of the access device.

The aforementioned data is processed for security reasons for fraud and abuse control as well as for statistical recording of internet usage. The legal basis for the processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f GDPR.

§ 4 Duration of the processing

The personal data will be deleted after five years if the member has not used the FTC internet connection within this period.

§ 5 Requirement of data provision

The provision of personal data is necessary for internet use.

§ 6 Right of objection

The member has the right to object at any time to the personal data processed on the basis of Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 f GDPR, provided that there are grounds for the objection arising from his/her particular situation. However, his personal data

shall be further processed if there are compelling legitimate grounds to further process the data which override the interests, rights and freedoms of his person, or if the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defense of legal claims.

§ 7 Further data subject rights

In the event that consent has been given, the member has the right to revoke it. A revocation does not change the lawfulness of the processing granted until the revocation (no retroactive effect of the revocation).

The member has the right to obtain, upon request and free of charge, information on the personal data held by the FTC concerning him/her (Article 15 of the GDPR).

Furthermore, in accordance with the GDPR, he has the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), deletion (Art. 17 GDPR), restriction (Art. 18 GDPR) and transfer (Art. 20 GDPR) of his personal data.

He/she also has the right to complain to the competent data protection supervisory authority in justified cases (Art. 77 GDPR).

The member may assert his/her rights under the GDPR by e-mail or in writing.
